Plaintiff, received letter from this court dated, 11/18/2025 on 12/23/2025.

Plaintiff is currently at Greenville Corr. Cntr, in an Infirmary 4U-11-B #3 ward, since 12/10/2025.

Plaintiff states he was at VCU, 10/17/ - 10/20/2025, a 2 week respite, the resection of 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> digit, L. foot.

Further that (6) days later another re-infection, from a new culture that was returned to VCU, from 11/30/2025 to 12/10/2025, of which the bacteria (Serratia) was confirmed, and was to be given Zosyn intravenous, 4 times a day for 43 days. (19 days in VCU Hospital).

Further, that a p/w line, in R. arm to receive antibiotics was placed least 1/15/2025. A 50 to 60% chance to keep R. Foot.

Further, due to 2 stitches busted, swelling, drainage, a hole is still 1 1/2" by 5/8" wide, and depends upon full, healing, Hospital, Doctor, and D.O.C. approvals, before return, and Infectious Disease Control, to access, if cultures are consistent. Yet, re-infection can not be ruled out.

Plaintiff, has his legal Papercase at BKCC, albeit, 3 searches, many pages were destroyed, and further records not known till evaluation, of said records, when property is returned.

Further, upon arrival at BKCC, 2 responses by Fed. Ct, took 29 days to "receive" property in possession.

Plaintiff, can not fulfill, deadlines, and even called this Court, by Prison phone on 12/30/2025, not answered, pending approval, by Clerk. Plaintiff will advise the court, upon returning to BKCC, and property in his possession. Plaintiff seeks extension to such time, and a total 30 days to respond, after receipt of property. Forgive plaintiff for such beyond his control.
