Dear Sir:

I write pursuant to the Court's Rule 12.6 to advise you of the petitioners' belief that Hon. Gregory Abbott, Governor of Texas, who was a party in the district court proceeding in this matter, has no interest in the outcome of a petition for *certiorari*, if petitioners were to file one.

My basis for this belief is that the district court dismissed petitioners' complaint against Governor Abbott in an Order dated August 2, 2022. *See La Unión del Pueblo Entero v. Abbott*, Case No. 5:21-cv-0844-XR, Doc. No. 447, reported at 618 F.Supp.3d 449, 501, 504 (W.D.Tx. 2022).

I note that the lawyers in the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Texas who represented the Governor in the district court until the case against him was dismissed are copied on this letter (and were served with the petitioners' Application) and are therefore on notice of this Rule 12.6 letter.
