APPLICATION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE A PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI TO THE UNITED STATES COURT OF APPEALS FOR THE NINTH CIRCUIT

To the Honorable Elena Kagan, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court and Circuit Justice for the Ninth Circuit:

- 1. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rules 13.5, 22, and 30, Applicant Aviagames, Inc. respectfully requests a 45-day extension of time, up to and including February 19, 2026, to file a petition for a writ of certiorari to the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit, seeking review of that court's August 27, 2025 decision in *Pandolfi v. Aviagames, Inc.*, No. 24-5817, 2025 WL 2463742 (9th Cir. Aug. 27, 2025). The decision below is attached as Appendix A. The jurisdiction of this Court will be invoked under 28 U.S.C. § 1254.
- 2. Applicant timely petitioned for panel rehearing and rehearing en banc. The panel denied rehearing on October 6, 2025. The order denying Applicant's petition for panel rehearing is attached as Appendix B.

3. Applicant timely moved to stay the mandate, which the panel granted on October 15, 2025. The order staying the mandate is attached as Appendix C.

4. The time to file a petition for a writ of certiorari will otherwise expire on January 5, 2026. This Application is timely because it has been filed more than ten days prior to the date on which the time for filing is due to expire.

5. Applicant has good cause for an extension of time. This petition involves substantial and complex issues under the Federal Arbitration Act. Applicant has retained new counsel, who will benefit from additional time to gain familiarity with the record and case. Counsel for Applicant likewise has multiple filings and arguments in the intervening weeks, including before this Court. The quality of any petition would greatly benefit from an extension of time to allow Jones Day to further develop the arguments in this case and to complete the requisite research and writing.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that an order be entered extending the time to file a petition for a writ of certiorari for 45 days, up to and including February 19, 2026.
