Donald Wayne Read, Petitioner moves this Court to
grant an extension of time to file Petition of Certiorari

The Sixth Court of Appeals, Texas rendered judgement
in COA # 06-24-00072, PD-0622-25 on 10/24/2025
and Petition For Discretionary Review was denied on 09/29/2025

Donald Wayne Read seeks a 60 day extension () of which the current deadline of 90 days is due 01/21/2026. The additional 60 days would extend the deadline to 03/21/26

Petitioner was arrested in the parking lot of Harris Methodist Northwest Hospital in Azle, Texas as attempting to obtain emergency medical assistance due to inguinal hernia diagnosed 12/09/2021 which was causing excruciating extreme pain. While incarcerated at Tarrant Co Jail Fort Worth, TX. John Peter Smith hosp. performed surgery and as a continuing patient still undergoing follow-up treatment signed a medical refusal on 11/19/2025 in order to meet requirement of these conditions.

In addition, after being transfer to TDCJ and housed at Beto Unit when then assigned to Coffield unit and unable to carry the 20-40lbs of accumulated trial transcript, letters from employer, medical records, Financial and income tax records were lost by the property room and/or transport of the property by TDCJ officials - prison grievance # 2025040199 Filed 12/17/24. Petitioner's attorney Cody Coker furnished a second trial transcript record, but was missing crucial documentation originally obtained in the first record provided. Since petitioner's attorney has not furnished record of transcript for Motion hearing for New Trial or missing "Counts Charge", petitioner is attempting with all effort to obtain these essential court records.

When info. of judgment was received the Coffield Field Unit was on annual search-lock down and "Access to Counts" was not conveniently available for legal education and/or research. Having not earned a degree in jurisprudent it will be essential to

utilized every instance to support and maintain all of my rights, privileges, immunities, and protection of the "Rule of Law" in this matter of Justice, so I may acquire the life, liberty, and pursuit of Happiness guaranteed by Our Founding Father's "Bill of Rights" and additional 14th U.S. Const.

This is the initial request for extension of time to file in which an additional 60 days from Jan. 21st, 2026 would then extend the deadline (Where's the guaranteed right?) to March 21st, 2026

For these reasons Donald Wayne Read request the court grant Donald Wayne Read's motion to extend time for Filing "Petition For Certiorari."
