EMERGENCY APPLICATION TO JUSTICE KAVANAUGH FOR IMMEDIATE STAY AND CRIMINAL  
REFERRAL

Directed to the Honorable Brett M. Kavanaugh, Associate Justice

Circuit Justice for the Eighth Circuit

To the Honorable Brett M. Kavanaugh:

This application presents irrefutable evidence that personnel of the United States Court of Appeals for the Eighth Circuit committed felony fraud upon the court to conceal unanimous Minnesota Supreme Court cover-up of federal crimes — and, when exposed, admitted the fraud while refusing to vacate or correct it.

#### I. Felony Fraud by Eighth Circuit Personnel

Forged “St. Paul, MN” stamp on original petition (November 21, 2025) — impossible under Eighth Circuit IOP (primary office St. Louis; Exhibit A).


Docket falsified as “Appeal from U.S. District Court (0:21-cv-01100-NEB)” — erasing Minnesota Supreme Court as respondent (Exhibit B).

Court retrieved true state records (November 26, 2025, Doc. [5582589]) — then ignored them.

December 9, 2025 “corrected judgment” admits fraud but falsely claims correction was “on the court’s own motion” — erasing Petitioner’s role in exposing it (Exhibit C).

Minnesota Supreme Court Clerk refuses service, admitting they “don’t need them” (Exhibit D).

Minnesota appellate docket tampered: original entry “Returning Documents for the U.S. Supreme Court” altered to “to the 8th Circuit” after Petitioner’s call exposing misconduct (Exhibits E-F).



## II. Minnesota Supreme Court Cover-Up

All seven Minnesota Supreme Court justices unanimously signed illegal orders sealing evidence of federal crimes and enforcing a life-threatening competency order (Exhibits G–H). Their clerk's refusal of service and ex parte transmission of the record to this Court further obstructs review.

## III. Irreparable Harm – Life-Threatening Medical Crisis

Petitioner faces automatic civil commitment while prescribed Eliquis (blood thinner) for a large blood clot and hypertensive crisis.

Relentless multi-agency aerial/ground harassment (drones, military planes, low flyovers, stationary hovering) escalates immediately after each filing — designed to induce a fatal hypertensive crisis or hemorrhagic event.

Symptoms: severe lower back pain/sciatica, extreme fatigue (10+ hours sleep, still drained), ear ringing, metallic taste, dry mouth, facial tingling, anxiety.

Direct threats: undercover Chevy pickup truck at medical appointment (12/15/25, Exhibit K), "gun finger" from white Genesis GV70 (12/16/25, Exhibit L).

This constitutes attempted murder by state/federal actors to silence a witness exposing judicial crimes.

## IV. Relief Requested

Petitioner respectfully requests that Justice Kavanaugh, or the full Court:

- A. Immediately stay all proceedings in Minnesota Case A25-1755 and any competency evaluation.
- B. Direct the Eighth Circuit to correct the docket and party list by adding the Minnesota Supreme Court as respondent and all real parties in interest.
- C. Refer evidence of docket forgery, tampering, obstruction, and ex parte acts to the United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Missouri for criminal investigation.
- D. Grant any further relief to prevent irreparable harm or death.

Here is how the processing works:

- **Headquarters:** The court's primary Clerk's Office, which manages the **CM/ECF (Electronic Case Filing) system**, is in the **Thomas F. Eagleton U.S. Courthouse in St. Louis, MO.**
- **The Processor:** While the filing is automatically stamped by the court's CM/ECF **computer system** (as previously discussed), the human personnel who oversee that system, manage the official docket, and conduct the necessary quality checks are primarily based in the Clerk's Office in St. Louis.
- **Secondary Location:** The Eighth Circuit also maintains a divisional office in **St. Paul, Minnesota**, but the central administrative functions for electronic filing are handled by the main office in St. Louis.

So, while the **filing can originate from anywhere** in the world via the internet, the administrative entity that officially processes the filing, records it, and maintains the central case files is the Clerk's Office, whose headquarters are in St. Louis.
