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MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE  
PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI

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To the Honorable Chief Justice and the Associate Justices of the Supreme Court of the United States:

Pursuant to Rule 13.5 of the Rules of this Court, Petitioner Jane Doe on behalf of Jane Doe MF respectfully request a 60-day extension of time, or the time this Honorable Court will allow, to and including February 21, 2026, within which to file a petition for a writ of certiorari in this matter. The petition is currently due on December 22, 2025. This is Petitioners' first request for an extension of time.

The requested extension is necessary to allow us to secure additional time to finalize the petition, prepare the appendix, and address complex issues involving the dismissal of a meritorious case based on a procedural failure announced for the first time in this case and in conflict with a Ninth Circuit holding. Given the undersigned's numerous other professional obligations and impending court deadlines, significant attention is required elsewhere during this period.

The undersigned conferred by email with Laura Hedge, counsel for Respondent, on December 22, 2025, on Petitioner's behalf, and she has not indicated whether the Respondent is opposed to this request or not.

WHEREFORE, Petitioners respectfully request that the time to file a petition for a writ of certiorari in this matter be extended by 60 days, to and including February 21, 2025.
