

Motion to Extend Deadline

Petitioner/ Defendant/Appellant Eduardo Luciano, pro se, an inmate with the Federal Bureau of Prisons currently incarcerated at United States Penitentiary McCreary in Pine Knot, Kentucky, whose motion for panel rehearing in Case No. 24-1251 was DENIED in an order dated November 5, 2025 (DE 32), submits this motion to extend deadline, and states the following:

Luciano will seek a writ of certiorari. In his trial, a juror lied about not knowing the prosecutor during voir dire. Subsequently, after allegedly hearing the prosecutor make her opening remarks, she "remembered" her voice from a one-time meeting. Talking with another juror, she was convinced to make the court aware of this knowledge.

The court did a thorough re-examination of said juror, where she swore that she could be impartial. The court refused to strike the juror for cause. Luciano will argue that this was an abuse of discretion. Moreover, Luciano had a preemptory strike available as he had not used all his strikes in voir dire. Counsel indicated that, regardless of cause, if he had known that the juror knew the prosecutor, he would have struck [RECEIVED] juror.



Luciano has written the Clerk of Court for the Supreme Court, asking for the forms and instructions for certiorari, but as of January 2, 2026, he has not received them back. Additionally, USP McCreary is an extremely poorly run institution.

even by the laughably low standards of the Federal Bureau of Prisons, with frequent lockdowns, lack of law library, a copier that has been broken for literally months, etc. As such, Luciano reuires more time that the 90 days he is entitled to to file ceritorari. He respectfully requests an additional 90 days to file, or whatever time interval this court deems appropriate under the circumstances.
