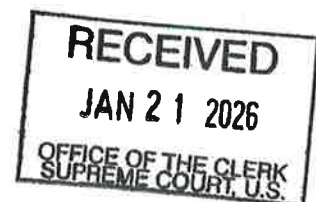
Dear Clerk of the Court:


