**APPLICATION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE

1. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 13.5, Petitioner RONALD ANTHONY BEASLEY, II, respectfully requests a sixty (60) day extension of time, until May 1, 2026, within which to file a petition for writ of certiorari.
