BY ORDER OF THE COURT:


Due to Petitioner, Muriel Fiedler's, and Respondent, Robert E. Fiedler's, apparent abuse of the legal process by their abusive, repetitive, malicious, or frivolous pro se filings pertaining to Seminole County Circuit Court case number 592015-CA-412, this Court issued an order directing Petitioner, Muriel Fiedler, and Respondent, Robert E. Fiedler, to show cause why they should not be prohibited from future pro se filings. See State v. Spencer, 751 So. 2d 47, 48 (Fla. 1999). Having carefully considered the Responses and finding they fail to show cause why sanctions should not be imposed, we conclude that Petitioner, Muriel Fiedler, and Respondent, Robert E. Fiedler, are abusing the judicial process and should be barred from further pro se filings.

Therefore, in order to conserve judicial resources, it is

ORDERED that Petitioner, Muriel Fiedler, and Respondent, Robert E. Fiedler, separately or together, are prohibited from filing with this Court any further pro se filings concerning the above referenced case. The Clerk of this Court is directed not to accept any further pro se filings concerning the referenced case. Any future filings regarding the referenced case will be summarily rejected by the Clerk, unless filed by a member in good standing of The Florida Bar. See Isley v. State, 652 So. 2d 409, 411 (Fla. 5th DCA 1995) ("Enough is enough."). It is further

ORDERED that this original proceeding is dismissed.
