

**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE AN OUT-OF-TIME PETITION FOR A WRIT  
OF CERTIORARI**

Angela Campbell (“Campbell”), Petitioner *pro per*, respectfully moves this Court for leave to file Campbell’s Petition for a Writ of Certiorari out of time, pursuant to Rule 13.5 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States.

In support of this motion, Campbell states:

1. The judgment of the United States Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit was issued on March 28, 2025, and under Supreme Court Rule 13.1, the petition was due no later than June 26, 2025.
2. Campbell made every effort to timely prepare and submit Campbell’s Petition for a Writ of Certiorari. However, Campbell relied in good faith on the informal assistance of a non-practicing attorney who was aiding in the preparation and formatting of the writ and associated documents. This individual misunderstood or miscalculated the filing deadline. *See* Campbell’s Declaration (Exhibit A) and Donna Patik’s Affidavit (Exhibit B).
3. The miscalculation of the filing deadline was neither intentional nor negligent on the part of Campbell, but rather the result of an honest mistake in calculating the 90-day period from the date the rehearing was denied.
4. Courts have recognized that where an out-of-time filing results from attorney error – especially when committed by individuals offering informal assistance – relief may be warranted under compelling circumstances. *See Bowles v. Russell*, 551 U.S. 205 (2007) (recognizing the strict limits on appellate deadlines but highlighting the tension between rigid timeliness and equitable considerations); cf. *Holland v. Florida*, 560 U.S. 631 (2010) (equitable tolling available in *habeas corpus* proceedings for reasonable reliance on counsel’s miscalculation).
5. Campbell is a non-prisoner *pro per* litigant who paid the full civil filing fee, and whose petition raises urgent constitutional questions of judicial recusal, procedural due process, and access to justice for unrepresented litigants. These are matters of national significance and structural concern, particularly given the record showing financial conflicts and undisclosed relationships affecting the presiding judge in the district court.
6. Campbell acted with diligence throughout the preparation and filing process. Campbell submitted this Motion for Leave to File an Out-of-time Petition for a Writ of Certiorari as soon as the error was discovered with minimal delay. No prejudice would result to the Respondents or the Court by granting this motion.

## **Conclusion**

For these reasons, Campbell respectfully requests that this Court grant leave to file Campbell's Petition for a Writ of Certiorari out of time and docket the Petition as submitted.


I, Angela Campbell, declare that:
