I write on behalf of petitioners in *Allen v. Caster*, No. 26-116, and appellants in *Allen v. Milligan*, No. 26-117, and *Allen v. Singleton*, No. 26-118. The petition for a writ of certiorari in *Caster* and the jurisdictional statements in *Milligan* and *Singleton* were filed on July 22, 2026, and docketed on July 24, 2026. On September 18, 2026, *Caster* respondents filed a brief in opposition, *Milligan* appellees filed a motion to dismiss or affirm, and *Singleton* appellees filed a motion to dismiss.
