ORDER

This matter comes before the court upon the Motion for Extension of Time to File a Motion for Rehearing and the accompanying Application for an Order Shortening Time (collectively, “Motion for Extension”) filed on behalf of Plaintiff-Appellant People of Guam (“People”) by the Office of the Attorney General (“OAG”) on January 28, 2026. The OAG seeks a 30-day extension of time to file a petition for rehearing from this court’s January 15, 2026, order and requests expedited consideration. Mot. at 2 (Jan. 28, 2026); Appl. at 1-2 (Jan. 28, 2026).

On January 15, 2026, this court denied Appellees’ motion to dismiss and prospectively conditioned further proceedings in this appeal on the timely appearance of conflict-free substitute counsel for the People. Order at 4 (Jan. 15, 2026). That order expressly prohibited the OAG from prosecuting this appeal while the Superior Court’s disqualification order remains in effect. *Id.* The Motion for Extension was signed and submitted by counsel previously disqualified and not by conflict-free substitute counsel, in direct violation of this court’s January 15, 2026, order. *Id.*

Guam Rules of Appellate Procedure (“GRAP”) 27(a) and 32 authorize this court to enforce compliance with its orders and strike noncompliant filings. Guam R. App. P. 6(b), 27(a), 32; *see also* 48 U.S.C.A. § 1424-1(a)(6); 7 GCA § 3108(c)(2). Accordingly, the Motion for Extension is **STRICKEN** in its entirety for failure to comply with this court’s January 15, 2026, order requiring the timely appearance of conflict-free substitute counsel as a condition of further

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1 prosecuting this appeal. This court will not entertain further filings from disqualified counsel.
2 Any future filings on behalf of the People must be submitted by conflict-free substitute counsel
3 in accordance with the January 15, 2026, order.
