**BRIEF FOR RESPONDENT IN RESPONSE
TO PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI**

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Respondent Mike Dennis files this response at the Court's request. *See* Docket entry August 17, 2026; and Sup. Ct. Rule 15.1. Respondent has no additions to the petition's statement of the parties or of directly related proceedings.

The judgment below rests on a California failure-to-warn claim premised on the absence of a cancer warning on Roundup's label. This Court addressed that category of claim in *Monsanto Co. v. Durnell*, No. 24-1068 (June 25, 2026). Respondent does not oppose the disposition the petition requests, which would leave it to the California Court of Appeal to apply *Durnell* to this record in the first instance.

CONCLUSION

Respondent does not oppose an order granting the petition, vacating the judgment of the California Court of Appeal, and remanding for further proceedings not inconsistent with *Durnell*.
