I am counsel for Respondents in this case. Petitioners filed their Petition for a Writ of Certiorari on August 18, 2026 and a response is due on September 18, 2026.

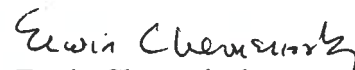
