REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSE TO PETITION

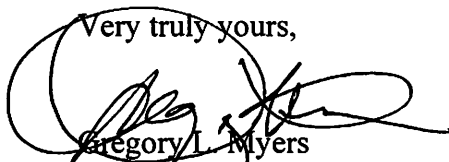
Dear Mr. Harris,

Pursuant to Rule 30.4, Respondents Michael Coleman, Kristin Blanco, Barry Lindaman, Breann Morse, Ted Destrampe and Rene Adamo, in their official capacities as board members of Maricopa Unified School District, Respondents in the above-entitled matter, case no. 26-237 request that the time for filing a response to the petition herein be extended thirty (30) days to October 23, 2026.
