I represent Respondents in the above-captioned matter. A brief in opposition to the petition for certiorari is currently due on October 1, 2026. I respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, that the time to file a response be extended to October 30, 2026. Petitioners consent to this request.
