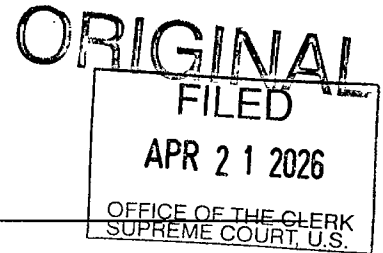

The petitioner, Ann Lutnes, asks leave to file the attached Petition for a Writ of Mandamus without prepayment of costs and to proceed in forma pauperis.

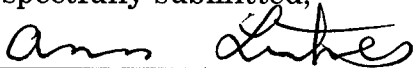
