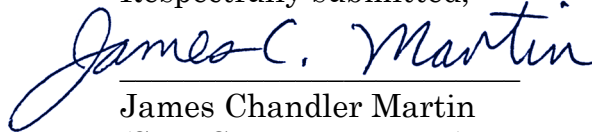
**MOTION TO PROCEED ON WRIT OF CERTIORARI

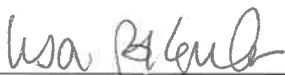
It appearing to the Court that Jorge Guevara has stated that he would be filing a Notice of Appeal of the final order entered on November 14, 2022, and
