I, Seth McKee, being first duly sworn, state under oath as follows:

1. I am over eighteen years of age, competent to testify, and make this affidavit based upon my personal knowledge.
2. I am the petitioner who personally prepared and filed a Petition for Writ of Mandamus in the Supreme Court of Oklahoma concerning jurisdictional issues arising from proceedings in Payne County, Oklahoma.

**I. NOVEMBER 20, 2025 — INITIAL FILING
ATTEMPT**

3. On November 20, 2025, I personally appeared at the Oklahoma Supreme Court Clerk's Office in Oklahoma City to file my Petition for Writ of Mandamus. I presented a complete filing packet consisting of the Petition for Writ of

Mandamus, an appendix containing supporting materials, a cover page, a proposed order, and multiple copies intended for filing.

4. During that interaction the clerk made the following statements:

"We don't do cover sheets here."

"We don't need that. We can leave that out."

"You tell me what you want then. I can't determine anything."

These statements are reflected in my contemporaneous notes. (see Exhibit E ¶¶ 1-4).

5. The clerk further instructed that the documents needed to be stapled in a particular manner before they could be accepted. Due to these instructions I left the clerk's office to reorganize the filing packet and prepare additional copies.

II. NOVEMBER 21, 2025 — RETURN AND ACCEPTANCE OF FILING

6. On November 21, 2025, I returned to the Oklahoma Supreme Court Clerk's Office with the petition reorganized and separated into the document groups requested the previous day.
7. A different clerk assisted with the documents. That clerk acknowledged the nature of the filing, stating: "It's an original action for

mandamus, is that correct?" I confirmed that it was. (see Exhibit E ¶ 7).

8. The clerk described the internal review process, stating: "We have four referees upstairs," and indicated that referees review such filings and prepare recommendations for the Court. (see Exhibit E ¶ 9).
9. During the document handling process the clerk stated: "These are going in the trash because I've got a marked original." Certain documents presented for filing were discarded by the clerk after this statement. I did not consent to the discarding of these documents and did not understand at the time that they were being permanently removed. (see Exhibit E ¶ 10).
10. The required filing fee was collected. The petition was accepted and stamped for filing.

III. ADA ACCOMMODATION

11. During the interaction I disclosed that I have a traumatic brain injury and requested information regarding ADA accommodations for court proceedings. This disclosure is relevant to the reasonableness of my conduct throughout the filing process, including my response to shifting instructions from clerk personnel.
12. The clerk initially indicated she did not know what an ADA accommodation was. Following discussion, I was informed that ADA

accommodation requests are handled through the Administrative Office of the Courts.

IV. STATUS OF PETITION AND JURISDICTIONAL SIGNIFICANCE

13. To the best of my knowledge, the Petition for Writ of Mandamus was accepted for filing, the filing fee was paid, and the documents were processed through the clerk's office on November 21, 2025.
14. To the best of my knowledge and based upon review of the publicly available docket of the Supreme Court of Oklahoma, no order accepting jurisdiction, declining jurisdiction, denying relief, dismissing the petition, or otherwise disposing of the mandamus petition has ever been entered. The jurisdictional questions presented in the petition have never been adjudicated or resolved on the merits.

V. PRESERVATION OF RECORD

15. The events described in this affidavit were documented in contemporaneous notes created at or near the time of the interactions described herein. A true and correct copy of those contemporaneous notes is attached hereto as Exhibit E and incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth in this affidavit.

RELEVANT STATUTORY AND RULE
PROVISIONS

U.S. Const. amend. XIV - Due Process Clause

Constitutional provision guaranteeing that no state shall deprive any person of life, liberty, or property without due process of law.

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28 U.S.C. §1651. Writs

(a) The Supreme Court and all courts established by Act of Congress may issue all writs necessary or appropriate in aid of their respective jurisdictions and agreeable to the usages and principles of law.

28 U.S.C. §1257. State courts; certiorari

(a) Final judgments or decrees rendered by the highest court of a State in which a decision could be had, may be reviewed by the Supreme Court by writ of certiorari where the validity of a treaty or statute of the United States is drawn in question or where the validity of a statute of any State is drawn in question on the ground of its being repugnant to the Constitution, treaties, or laws of the United States, or where any title, right, privilege, or immunity is specially set up or claimed under the Constitution or the treaties or statutes of, or any commission held or authority exercised under, the United States.

Supreme Court Rule 20

Rule 20. Procedure on a Petition for an Extraordinary Writ

- 1. Issuance by the Court of an extraordinary writ authorized by 28 U. S. C. §1651(a) is not a matter of right, but of discretion sparingly exercised. To justify the granting of any such writ, the petition must show that the writ will be in aid of the Court's appellate jurisdiction, that exceptional circumstances warrant the exercise of the Court's discretionary powers, and that adequate relief cannot be obtained in any other form or from any other court.
- 2. A petition seeking a writ authorized by 28 U. S. C. §1651(a), §2241, or §2254(a) shall be prepared in all respects as required by Rules 33 and 34. The petition shall be captioned "*In re* [name of petitioner]" and shall follow, insofar as applicable, the form of a petition for a writ of certiorari prescribed by Rule 14. All contentions in support of the petition shall be included in the petition. The case will be placed on the docket when 40 copies of the petition are filed with the Clerk and the docket fee is paid, except that a petitioner proceeding *in forma pauperis* under Rule 39, including an inmate of an institution, shall file the number of copies required for a petition by such a person under Rule 12.2, together with a motion for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*, a copy of which shall precede

and be attached to each copy of the petition. The petition shall be served as required by Rule 29 (subject to subparagraph 4(b) of this Rule).

- 3. (a) A petition seeking a writ of prohibition, a writ of mandamus, or both in the alternative shall state the name and office or function of every person against whom relief is sought and shall set out with particularity why the relief sought is not available in any other court. A copy of the judgment with respect to which the writ is sought, including any related opinion, shall be appended to the petition together with any other document essential to understanding the petition.
- (b) The petition shall be served on every party to the proceeding with respect to which relief is sought. Within 30 days after the petition is placed on the docket, a party shall file 40 copies of any brief or briefs in opposition thereto, which shall comply fully with Rule 15 . If a party named as a respondent does not wish to respond to the petition, that party may so advise the Clerk and all other parties by letter. All persons served are deemed respondents for all purposes in the proceedings in this Court.
- 4. (a) A petition seeking a writ of habeas corpus shall comply with the requirements of 28 U. S. C. §§2241 and 2242 , and in particular with the provision in the last paragraph of §2242, which requires a statement of the "reasons for not

making application to the district court of the district in which the applicant is held." If the relief sought is from the judgment of a state court, the petition shall set out specifically how and where the petitioner has exhausted available remedies in the state courts or otherwise comes within the provisions of 28 U. S. C. §2254(b). To justify the granting of a writ of habeas corpus, the petitioner must show that exceptional circumstances warrant the exercise of the Court's discretionary powers, and that adequate relief cannot be obtained in any other form or from any other court. This writ is rarely granted.

- (b) Habeas corpus proceedings are *ex parte*, unless the Court requires the respondent to show cause why the petition for a writ of habeas corpus should not be granted. A response, if ordered, shall comply fully with Rule 15. Neither the denial of the petition, without more, nor an order of transfer to a district court under the authority of 28 U. S. C. §2241(b), is an adjudication on the merits, and therefore does not preclude further application to another court for the relief sought.
- 5. The Clerk will distribute the documents to the Court for its consideration when a brief in opposition under subparagraph 3(b) of this Rule has been filed, when a response under subparagraph 4(b) has been ordered and filed,

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when the time to file has expired, or when the right to file has been expressly waived.

- 6. If the Court orders the case set for argument, the Clerk will notify the parties whether additional briefs are required, when they shall be filed, and, if the case involves a petition for a common-law writ of certiorari, that the parties shall prepare a joint appendix in accordance with Rule 26.

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Supreme Court Rule 29 - Filing and Service

Rule 29 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States governs the filing and service of documents submitted to the Court, including petitions, motions, and other papers.

The rule establishes requirements concerning the method of filing, service upon parties, and proof of service.

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**Supreme Court Rule 33.2 - Document
Preparation (Pro Se Filings)**

Rule 33.2 establishes formatting requirements for documents filed by parties proceeding without counsel.

The rule specifies document preparation standards including page size, spacing, typeface, and length limitations applicable to pro se filings before the Court.

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**Supreme Court Rule 39 - Forma Pauperis
Proceedings**

Rule 39 governs proceedings in forma pauperis before the Supreme Court of the United States.

The rule establishes the procedures by which parties who cannot afford filing fees may seek permission to proceed without prepayment of costs.

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**Okla. Stat. tit. 10A § 1-4-201 - Emergency
Custody Authority**

Oklahoma statutory provision governing the circumstances under which a child may be taken into emergency custody.

The statute establishes the legal authority and procedural requirements for emergency removal and provides the framework within which courts must evaluate the necessity of emergency custody.

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**Okla. Stat. tit. 10A & 1-4-203 - Mandatory
Post-Deprivation Hearing**

Oklahoma statutory provision governing the mandatory judicial review following emergency custody of a child.

Section 1-4-203 requires that when a child is taken into emergency custody, the court must promptly conduct a hearing to determine whether continued custody and further proceedings are warranted and whether the court will exercise continuing jurisdiction over the matter.

The decision is cited in the Petition for the principle that jurisdiction is a threshold issue that must be resolved prior to the exercise of judicial power.

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Ex parte McCardle

Supreme Court decision recognizing that jurisdiction defines the power of a court to act and that without jurisdiction a court cannot proceed in any cause.

This authority is cited in the Petition for the foundational principle that jurisdiction is the prerequisite for the lawful exercise of judicial authority.
