CONSTITUTIONAL AND STATUTORY PROVISIONS INVOLVED

Constitutions create the structure of government and define individual rights and liberties. They are the most important authorities. The Constitution of the United States is the Supreme Law of the United States. Any Federal case or statute, or any state constitution case or statute that violates the U.S. Constitution is unconstitutional, which means it is completely invalid. So, the Constitution should be your first source to research your case. You should determine if a constitutional provision applies to your case at the beginning of your research. The first ten amendments to the Constitution known as the Bill of Rights along with the Fourteenth Amendment are the most important part of the Constitution. For criminal defendants and prisoners, they have guarantees of personal rights and liberties. The First Amendment (freedom of speech, religion, and association), Fourth Amendment (search and seizure), Fifth Amendment (grand jury indictment, double jeopardy, self-incrimination, and due process), Sixth Amendment (jury trials for crime and procedural rights), and Eighth Amendment (excessive bail and cruel and unusual punishment) are all very important. The Fourteenth Amendment is also very important because it prohibits state governments from depriving you of life, liberty, or property without the process of law. That is, certain legal procedures typically including notice and a hearing. It also guarantees the equal protection of law (meaning it bans discrimination by the state on the basis of race, sex, and national origin). The Fifth Amendment ensures that these guaranteed rights apply to both state and federal action.
