**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN
FORMA PAUPERIS**

The Petitioner, SHARON ELIZABETH KEEGAN, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39, hereby moves this Court for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

1. Ms. Keegan was determined to be indigent pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3006A, by a judge of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Georgia. Undersigned counsel was appointed to represent Ms. Keegan on appeal before the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit.
