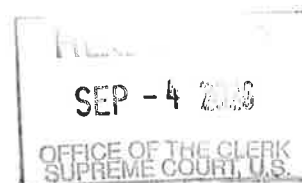
Dear Mr. Harris:

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, Respondent, United Financial Casualty Company, respectfully requests a thirty-day extension of time, to and including October 13, 2026, in which to file its brief in opposition to the petition for a writ of certiorari.

Respondent recently received notice that the petition for a writ of certiorari had been docketed and that Respondent's brief in opposition is due September 10, 2026. The abbreviated period between receiving notice of the petition and the current deadline does not provide Respondent sufficient time to review the petition and underlying record, consult with necessary personnel, and prepare a complete and adequately supported response.

In addition, undersigned counsel is not currently admitted to the Bar of this Court and must address the Court's admission requirements in connection with Respondent's representation in this matter. The additional time requested will permit Respondent to complete those necessary steps and to prepare and file an appropriate brief in opposition.
