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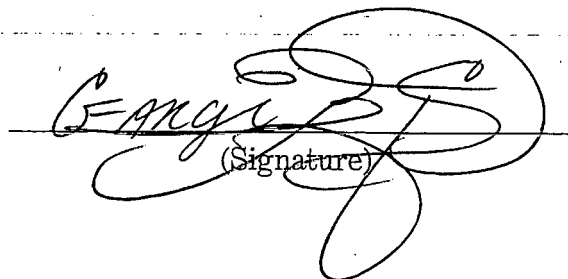
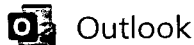

ORDER REGARDING MOTIONS

Appellant, who is proceeding in forma pauperis, has filed two motions for waiver of costs associated with preparation and delivery of transcripts. It appears that the writ of mandamus at issue in this appeal was decided without a hearing. Appellant requests transcripts from a hearing held August 29, 2024, and July 13, 2024. Appellant claims the August 29, 2024, transcript "is needed for future appeals" and that both transcripts are necessary for appellate review "in related cases" but does not explain their necessity for review in this appeal. See NRAP 9(a)(9). The motion is denied without prejudice.

Appellant has filed a motion for record of district court proceedings, requesting preparation of exhibits from a proceeding held November 22, 2024. This court's review is limited to the district court record. See NRAP 10; *Carson Ready Mix, Inc. v. First Nat'l Bank of Nev.*, 97 Nev. 474, 476, 635 P.2d 276, 277 (1981) (noting that this court may only consider matters appearing in the record on appeal). The district court record was transmitted January 23, 2026. To the extent that the exhibits appellant requests are included in the district court record, the motion is denied as moot. If the motion may be construed as a request to transmit

exhibits that are not included in the district court record, the motion is denied.

Appellant's motion for "expedition of appeal" is granted to the following extent. This court will expedite the resolution of this appeal to the extent that its docket will permit.
