

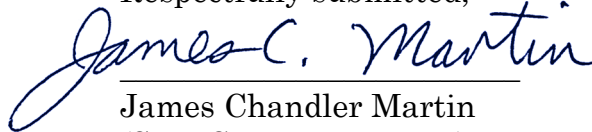
**MOTION TO PROCEED ON WRIT OF CERTIORARI
