CORRECTED MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

Petitioner, Ike Jackson, Jr., under Supreme Court Rule 39.1, requests leave to file a *Petition for a Writ of Certiorari* in this Court without payment of costs and to proceed *in forma pauperis*. Below, Petitioner was deemed indigent and appointed counsel. (Order Appointing Counsel, ECF No. 10.) A U.S. Magistrate Judge made that determination based on the Criminal Justice Act of 1964 (18 U.S.C. § 3006A).
