MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS*

Counsel for Petitioner, **Daniel Owen Conahan, Jr.**, respectfully requests leave of this Court to proceed *in forma pauperis* in this proceeding. Petitioner has been found indigent by each state and federal court in which he has challenged this conviction and sentence and has been permitted to proceed *in forma pauperis* before each of those courts: the Florida Supreme Court; the Circuit Court of the Twentieth Judicial Circuit in and for Charlotte County, Florida; the United States District

Court for the Middle District of Florida; and the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit.

The Office of the Capital Collateral Regional Counsel – South (CCRC-South) is a Florida state agency charged with the statutory responsibility of providing legal representation in both state and federal capital postconviction proceedings to people convicted and sentenced to death in Florida. Part IV, Chapter 27, Florida Statutes (1994), is the CCRC-South enabling statute. CCRC-South has been the counsel of record for Petitioner in his postconviction proceedings since April 24, 2003.

WHEREFORE, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39, Petitioner requests permission to proceed in this action *in forma pauperis*.
