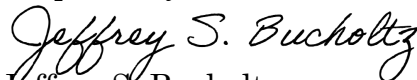
RE: Request for extension of time to file brief in opposition in *Custodia Bank, Inc. v. Federal Reserve Board of Governors, et al.*, No. 26-62
