In re ESTATE OF DARLENE JOYCE CALABRESE.

ORDER

Chase Hunter, the objector in the underlying Probate and Family Court case, filed two notices of appeal on May 31, 2024, and July 18, 2024, which were entered in this court under docket numbers 24-P-971 and 24-P-972, respectively. Hunter was subsequently ordered in each appeal to show cause why jurisdiction over the appeal was proper, given that no final order or judgment had entered in the Probate and Family Court. Hunter filed responses to the orders, and Joanne Auclair, the petitioner below, filed responses to Hunter's responses. A single justice of this court referred all of these filings to the panel designated to decide the appeals. The appeals were then consolidated under docket number 24-P-972.

Before filing her brief, Hunter filed a motion for a stay pending appeal under Mass. R. A. P. 6. A different single justice denied the motion, concluding that Hunter failed to show a likelihood of success on the merits. On January 7, 2025, Hunter filed a notice of appeal from the single justice's order, which was consolidated with the two earlier appeals. The

consolidated appeals were then briefed and assigned to this panel for decision.

We conclude that we lack jurisdiction over the consolidated appeals. The notice of appeal filed May 31, 2024, purports to appeal from orders docketed in the Probate and Family Court as paper numbers 257 to 262 and 266 to 270. These orders are all interlocutory and not immediately appealable. The notice of appeal filed July 18, 2024, purports to appeal from orders docketed in the Probate and Family Court as paper numbers 299 to 302. These orders are likewise interlocutory and not immediately appealable.

In responding to the show-cause orders, Hunter argued that a denial of a motion to disqualify opposing counsel is immediately appealable under the doctrine of present execution. Putting aside that only a subset of the orders appealed from concerns a request to disqualify counsel, the case that Hunter cites, Masiello v. Perini Corp., 394 Mass. 842 (1985), does not support her position. In fact, it supports the opposite. See id. at 850 ("We add that in the absence of authorization by a single justice of this court or the Appeals Court to seek interlocutory review of an order denying disqualification of counsel, . . . that order is not subject to appellate review until after final judgment on the merits of the underlying case").

The appeals filed May 31, 2024, and July 18, 2024, are thus improperly interlocutory and must be dismissed. See Linder v. Pollack, 102 Mass. App. Ct. 386, 390 (2023). This renders moot the January 7, 2025, appeal from the single justice's denial of a stay pending appeal. That appeal must also be dismissed.

Auclair has requested an award of her appellate attorney's fees and double costs on the ground that these appeals are frivolous and part of a pattern of vexatious litigation. We agree that the appeals are frivolous. Accordingly, within fourteen days of the date of this decision, Auclair may file an application for attorney's fees and double costs. Hunter may have fourteen days to respond. See Fabre v. Walton, 441 Mass. 9, 10-11 (2004).

Appeals dismissed.

GROUND'S FOR THIS REQUEST

1. The Application described in the caption was due on January 29, 2026.
2. On January 28, 2026, Objector/Petitioner/Appeals Court Appellant/SJC Applicant; herein referred to as "O/P/A") attempted to file a similar version of this motion that was erroneously rejected on January 29, 2026, by this Court's Clerk who erroneously connected this Application for Further Appellate Review with a then-pending Application for Further Appellate Review 30691 (see attached Bates 8-9).
3. On January 29, 2026, O/P/A made a second attempt to file a similar motion that was erroneously rejected on February 3, 2026, by this Court's Clerk who erroneously asserted that O/P/A already had a pending Application for Further Appellate Review (dated in November 2025) of Appeals Court Panel Order dated January 8, 2026, when O/P/A did not. (see attached Bates 10-11).
4. This is O/P/A's third attempt to file this motion.
5. On April 16, 2026, O/P/A received notice that her Application for Further Appellate Review #FAR30628 was denied.
6. But because of the Clerk's two erroneous rejections of O/P/A's

attempts to file this motion, O/P/A has been unfairly blocked from seeking further appellate review of the Appeals Court Order dated January 8, 2026.

7. O/P/A has other appellate litigation that has been made monumentally and unduly time-consuming as follows (all of which arise from unethical, deceptive acts against O/P/A by Joanne Auclair, O/P/A's sister which began on July 9, 2022, when Chase Hunter and Joanne Auclair's mother, Darlene Joyce Calabrese died)

- a. Due on about May 17, 2026: appellant brief in Mass. Appeals Court Panel appeal from Hampden County Superior Court 2379cv00413 (waiting for assembly of the record; this action was filed against O/P/A after Joanne Auclair bribed Florida citizens to use her impending fiduciary authority over Ms. Calabrese's assets to give O/P/A's alleged inheritance from Ms. Calabrese to them);
- b. Due on about May 17, 2026: appellant brief in Mass. Appeals Court Panel appeal 2025-P-0076 (arising from Attorney Susan McCoy illegally locking O/P/A out of her residence in October 2024 and in November 2024 - delayed because the trial court will not rule on pending motions since May 2025). yet transmitted the record to the Mass. Appeals Court Panel.

- c. Due on about May 17, 2026: appellant brief in Mass. Appeals Court Panel appeal of Palmer District Court Case 2543RO000212 (harassment complaint against Attorney Susan McCoy). All transcripts have been transmitted to the clerk. And the clerk has not yet transmitted the record to the Mass. Appeals Court Panel. O/P/A petitioned a Single Justice of the Appeals Court to appeal without assembly of the record (2025-J-0663). Denied.
- d. Due on about May 1, 2026: Mass. Single Justice Appeal from Hampden County Superior Court order that denied Plaintiff Hunter's indigency request for \$800 to purchase transcripts for Appeal from Hampden County Superior Court 2379cv00413;
- e. Due on about May 1, 2026: Mass. Supreme Judicial Court Motion for Reconsideration of Denial of Application for Further Appellate Review 30628 which arises from Mass. Appeals Court Panel appeal 2024-P-0972 which dismissed O/P/A's appeal.

ORDER

In an order issued on November 3, 2025, dismissing this appeal, we allowed petitioner-appellee Joanne Auclair's request for an award of her appellate attorney's fees and costs. Auclair has now submitted a motion for fees and costs in the total amount of \$13,525. The objector-appellant has filed a response raising various arguments, but no particular challenge to the amount of fees requested.

In determining what is a reasonable amount of attorney's fees, we "consider the nature of the case and the issues presented, the time and labor required, the amount of damages involved, the result obtained, the experience, reputation, and ability of the attorney, the usual price charged for similar services by other attorneys in the same area, and the amount of awards in similar cases. No one factor is determinative, and a factor-by-factor analysis, although helpful, is not required" (quotations omitted). Twin Fires Inv., LLC v. Morgan Stanley Dean Witter & Co., 445 Mass. 411, 430 (2005). We are not obliged to "review and allow or disallow each individual item in

the bill, but [may] consider the bill as a whole." Berman v. Linnane, 434 Mass. 301, 303 (2001). Ultimately, what constitutes a reasonable amount of attorney's fees is a matter of discretion for the court. See Twin Fires Inv., LLC, supra.

Here, after reviewing counsel's affidavit, we conclude that some of the time spent on the appeal was excessive, including the time spent preparing the motion for attorney's fees. Discounting that time, we conclude that a total amount of \$9,000 in fees and costs is fair and reasonable and thus award that amount. All other requests for relief contained in the motion are denied. Any proceedings to enforce the award shall be commenced in the Probate and Family Court.
