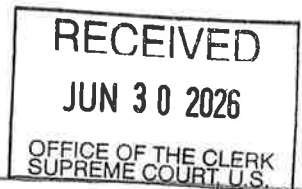

MOTION FOR EXTENSION



COMES NOW MR. DAMIEN FORD, PRO SE WITH HIS MOTION FOR EXTENSION, MR. FORD BRINGS HIS MOTION FOR EXTENSION TO THE UNITED STATES SUPREME COURT FOR THE FOLLOWING REASON(S):

1. MR. DAMIEN FORD SEEKS A (60) SIXTY DAY EXTENSION TO FILE WRIT OF CERTIORARI BECAUSE THE U.S. EASTERN DIST. OF ARKANSAS COURT REFUSES TO SEND MR.
