may deem just and proper.

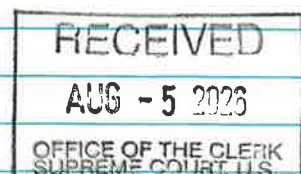

AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF MOTION TO Extend

says:

1. That I am the defendant/Petitioner and I am not represented by counsel.
2. That this affidavit is made in support of a motion for an extension of time to file and serve a writ of certiorari and poor person papers, which were due on July 27, 2026.
3. That an extension of time to file and serve the pro-se writ of certiorari and poor person papers is being sought for the following reasons:
 - A. I just recently looked on Westlaw and seen that my leave to appeal to the New York State Court of Appeals was denied and I never received any notice from the Court or assigned Counsel.
 - B. New York State Department of Corrections and Community Supervision has been in a state of emergency due to correctional officers on strike and getting fired. Since then access to the law library, legal materials and type writers have been severely

restricted, (hence my having to write out these motions).

C. I will have to write my entire writ of certiorari and poor person papers and any replies by hand and carbon copy them.
