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INTRODUCTION

Bridget Gilmore respectfully applies for an administrative stay to preserve the status quo pending further order of this Court. The stay is necessary to prevent enforcement of the Fifth Circuit mandate while Petitioner seeks review of the docket-processing and filing issues reflected in the record.

Petitioner requests an order staying the Fifth Circuit mandate and preserving the appellate record, including all docket entries, clerk notices, and filing metadata, until the Court can consider the matter further. The requested relief is narrow and does not ask the Court to decide the merits of the underlying appeal.

The record reflects a February 26, 2026 dismissal order, a March 31, 2026 rehearing-en-banc denial, a May 7, 2026 order denying motions to preserve evidence, vacate an order, correct the docket, strike filings, and stay the mandate, and May 12 and May 18 docket activity concerning later filings and "DOCUMENT RECEIVED - NO ACTION TAKEN" notices. Petitioner contends those events created an inaccurate and unstable appellate record, and that a stay is needed to prevent irreparable harm before review can occur.

JURISDICTION AND AUTHORITY

This Court has authority to entertain an application for a stay under Supreme Court Rule 23 and the Court's emergency stay practice. Petitioner seeks relief to preserve the Court's prospective jurisdiction and to prevent the mandate from issuing or taking effect before the Court can review the application.

REASONS FOR STAY

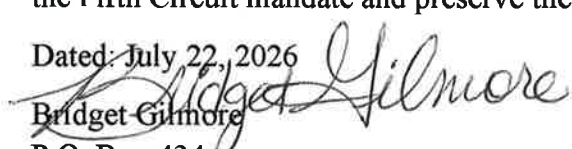
A stay is warranted because the existing record shows unresolved docket-processing issues and later filings that were not treated consistently by the Fifth Circuit clerk's office. Petitioner contends that absent a stay, the mandate may enforce a record that does not accurately reflect what was filed, when it was filed, or how it was processed.

The stay would not disturb the merits of the underlying case. It would only preserve the status quo so the Court may review the application on a stable record. Petitioner also contends that the relief sought is necessary because the Fifth Circuit already denied the relevant stay request and the later docket notices left additional filings unresolved.

CONCLUSION

For these reasons, Petitioner respectfully requests that the Court grant an administrative stay of the Fifth Circuit mandate and preserve the appellate record pending further proceedings.

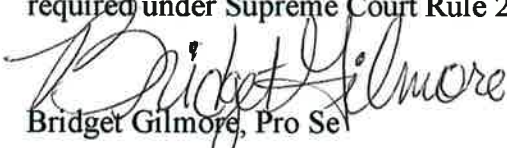

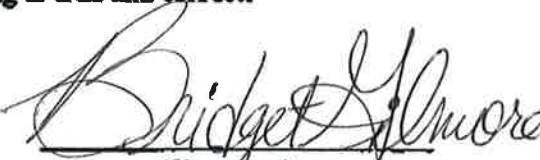
