**APPLICATION TO EXTEND THE TIME TO FILE A PETITION FOR A WRIT OF
CERTIORARI**

To the Honorable **Samuel A. Alito, Jr.**, Circuit Justice for the **Third** Circuit:

The Applicant, Kevin Kirk, respectfully requests a 60-day extension of time to file a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari in this Court, up to and including **September 8, 2026**.

1. PARTIES TO THE APPLICATION

The sole party seeking this extension is the Applicant, **Kevin Kirk**, who has proceeded as *pro se* and filing *In Forma Pauperis* is currently attempting to secure an attorney by selling his home during this time of financial hardship.

2. JUDGMENT SOUGHT TO BE REVIEWED

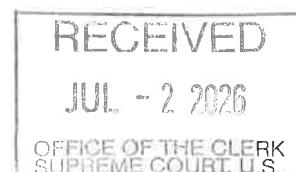
The judgment sought to be reviewed is the decision of the **Superior Court of New Jersey** in Case No: A-003732-23, decided on **April 10, 2026**. A copy of that opinion is attached to this application as Exhibit A.

3. JURISDICTION

This Court has jurisdiction over the timely filed petition under 28 U.S.C. § 1257(a), as it involves an appeal from a final judgment rendered by a State court. The original deadline for the Petition is **July 9, 2026**. This application is being filed on or before **June 29, 2026**, satisfying the 10-day advance requirement of Supreme Court Rule 13.5. 4. JUSTIFICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME ("GOOD CAUSE")

The Applicant is currently facing severe financial hardship and cannot afford legal representation. The Applicant is actively taking concrete steps to secure counsel by placing their primary home up for sale to raise the necessary legal funds.



Simultaneously, the Applicant is actively interviewing qualified appellate attorneys to take the case once those funds clear.


Because the Applicant is currently unrepresented, financially challenged, and managing an active home sale, extra time is required to ensure an attorney can properly research and draft the complex constitutional questions in the forthcoming petition.

Wherefore, Applicant respectfully requests that an order be entered extending the time to file a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari by 60 days, to and including **September 8, 2026**.
