MOTION TO EXTEND TIME ON PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI

Now comes, Dani Ray Malm, Petitioner in pro se and respectfully asks this Honorable Court to afford Petitioner an additional 30 days to file a Petition for Writ of Centiorari, for the following reasons:

1. On August 6, 2025, the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit denied Petitioners application for a certificate of Appealability, in case No. 25-1184, Malm V. Curley.
2. May 19, 2026, Petitioner filed a motion for Reconsideration which was construed as a Petition for panel rehearing and denied. The motion for an extension of time was granted.
3. June 23, 2026, Petitioner filed a petition for Panel Rehearing and Motion to Extend Time, the submissions were returned unfiled. The Sixth Circuit claims case No. 25-1184 is now closed, and the review of this case is complete, (see attachment).
4. Petitioner is a simple laymen, far from proficient in law and is proceeding in Pro se.
5. Petitioner is currently housed at Newberry Correctional Facility in Newberry, MICHigan. Access to the prison law library for legal research and copies is sporadic at best.
6. The Petition for Writ of Centiorari is currently due on September 20, 2026. Petitioner is requesting an additional 30 day extension. Leaving Petitioner approximately 60 days to bring forth the best possible Petition, Petitioner could successfully accomplish within this time frame.

7. Petitioner hopes and prays that this Court will accept this Motion to Extend Time under Supreme Court rule 30 (2). So this Petition for Writ of Certiorari would be due on or before October 20, 2026.

Wherefore, Petitioner, Dani Ray Malm moves this Honorable Court to Grant this Motion to Extend Time an additional 30 days.
