Petitioner, Mohammad Khan, the Petitioner in the above-referenced matter, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 33.2 and 30.3 submits this Application for Motion for Extension of Time to File Brief to Petition For Writ of Certiorari to the Clerk for the Purpose of respectfully requesting Justice Keegan to grant a sixty day(60)day extension of time to file petitioners Brief to Petition For Writ of Certiorari up to and including October 25th 2026 which is a Sunday . Petitioner request that the court toll the extension to October 26th 2026 while petitioner determines the remedy of court error and outcome of a timely motion En Banc In further support, Petitioner would respectfully show as follows..

- 1.) The Petitioner and Appellant received an Order affirming the lower courts order from the Ninth Circuit Court of appeals on May 28th 2026 (exhibit).
- 2.) Petitioner Then Timely Filed a Motion to En Banc on or about June 11th 2026 prior to the mandate being issued and the expiration of the 14 day period as indicated in the FRAP rules for time allowed to file a petition for rehearing or Extension of time to file the petition for rehearing In the 9th Circuit court of appeals(exhibit) is allowed to be filed for unprecedented issues which was timely filed and inappropriately docketed on the wrong day by the clerks of 9th circuit Court of Appeals.

The Clerk's office incorrectly filed this motion on the incorrect date on about June 12th 2026 1 days after the receipt through the EDSS submission system date stamped 6/11/26 on the EDSS system receipt (exhibit) to prevent me from use of law cited

in this motion which is currently in-limbo in the Ninth Circuit court of Appeals. There have been multiple errors in multiple clerks offices at this point which is "serious" and indicates that my civil rights are being taken away at the court level in different courts due to these errors or a more sinister attack on my case outcome. And this happened to my family member as well in the same court.

3.) Petitioner was diagnosed with Dementia and petitioner is 84 years old and bedridden in the hospital.

4.) Petitioner has been victim of civil rights Violations many related cases are pending. Petitioner has just recently discovered a scheme cited and filed in the 9th circuit in the En banc filing 6/11/26 by the current administration which violates the civil rights of United States citizens while using Violations of the Computer Fraud Abuse Act to cover up Evidence and spy on United States citizens illegally to conduct espionage and theft of trade secrets in illegal effort to self deal and abuse power of the office and administration of the United States of America and also use and abuse the US Courts and US Department of Justice and other agencies to get away with these crimes. This Abuse also comes as The Current President uses Sanctions on Foreign born United States Citizens to abuse its power to cover-up crimes against US Citizen and Birth Right Citizenship through the Alien Enemies Act as justification to the violation of Theft of Trade Secrets and espionage and masks a global war with this abhorrent Scheme to violate civil rights and using the United States Bankruptcy Courts and endangering the United States economy as a tool to force Americans into bankruptcy and enforce this illegal scheme to acquire assets unfairly .(example of what Trump Media, DJT symbol is , using trusts for) In my case interfering with espionage in Business interfering with banking rights, business and real estate contracts and Violating Bankruptcy automatic stays has been a tool to get to this point and this particular case

Petitioner will use this time to determine rights and placement of the required briefs to be filed in the related courts under FRAP 27.1 and FRAP 27-3 and under Title 28 USC Section 1651 All Writs Act Title 28 USC Section 2254.

5.) Petitioner filed this Motion for an extension of time on or about 8/25/2026 and timely within the time frame required and deadline to file Petitioners Brief to Petition For Writ of Certiorari which is 90 Days or on or August 26th, 2026 Deadline after the order was issued on 5/28/26 (exhibit).

6.) Pursuant to Supreme Clerk Court Rule 33.2 and rule 30.3 and rule 30.4, the relief herein requested " may be presented in the form of a application by setting out specific reasons why an extension of time is justified. Petitioner May request that the motion be submitted to a justice or to the Court to be granted

7.). This is the Petitioners first request for an extension of time to file it petition.

8.) Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 33.2 and rule 30.3 and rule 30.4 , the Court has the authority to grant the additional time requested herein.

9.. Petitioner requests and extension of time to file is petition based on the following specific reasons pursuant to Rule 33.2 and 30.3

a. Petitioner has dementia and needs help , (Exhibit)

b. Petitioner requires this time to determine the outcome of the pending motion in the 9th circuit Court of appeals filed on 6/11/26 and incorrectly filed on 6/12/26 (exhibit)

c. Petitioner requires this time to consult with Attorneys . (exhibit)

d.) This matter is unprecedented

10.. Petitioner requests this time to determine under FRAP 27.1 and FRAP 27-3 and under Title 28 USC Section 1651 All Writs Act Title 28 USC Section 2254 the unprecedented issues regarding stay and abeyance of the issues listed above and attached as the pending motion en banc and related cases in which pending cases and new evidence of extrinsic fraud interfered with Petitioners due process Under Supreme court rule 23 in Re Rhines v Weber, 544 U.S 269 (2005) and in Re Gonzales v. Wong 667 F.3d 965 (9th Cir 2011) and also In Re Cullen v Pinholster 563 U.S. 170 (2011).

11.) Petitioner will suffer irreparable harm if this motion for an extension of time is not granted.

Based on the foregoing , the Petitioner respectfully request a sixty (60) day extension of time to file the requested responsive brief up to and including October 26th 2026
