

To the Honorable Samuel Alito, as Circuit Justice for the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit, including Appeals from the Pennsylvania Supreme Court for Pennsylvania Supreme Court Case No. 163 MAL 2026:

In accordance with this Court's rules 13.5, Applicant Ryan Givey respectfully requests that the time to file his petition for a writ of certiorari be extended for 60 days, up to and including December 24, 2026. 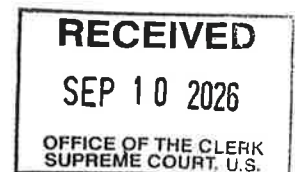
