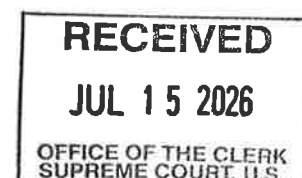

Motion for Extension of Time Pursuant to Rule 30.4

Dear Mr. Harris:

Pursuant to Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, Petitioner respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days, until **August 19, 2026**, to comply with the Court's Order dated June 29, 2026, requiring payment of the docketing fee under Rule 38(a) and submission of a petition in compliance with Rule 33.1.

Good cause exists for this request.



The Court's Order was mailed on June 29, 2026. At that time, Petitioner was traveling outside the United States on a previously planned trip. While Petitioner was in Nepal, a roommate checked the mailbox and informed Petitioner on **July 4, 2026**, that correspondence had been received from the Court. Petitioner did not have access to the case files, computer, or drafting materials while traveling.

Petitioner returned to China on **July 10, Friday, 2026**, where Petitioner's case materials and computer were located. Because July 11 and 12 were the weekend, Petitioner was unable to begin contacting Supreme Court printing services until **Monday, July 13,**

2026. Petitioner promptly contacted a Supreme Court legal printing service to obtain a review of the case and a quotation for preparation of a Rule 33.1 booklet petition. That review is currently underway.

Petitioner is proceeding **pro se** and is making substantial revisions to the petition to ensure compliance with the Court's formatting requirements and the requirements of Rule 33.1. Additional time is necessary to complete those revisions, finalize the professionally printed booklet, pay the required docketing fee, and submit the petition in the form required by the Court.

This request is made in good faith, before the current deadline, and solely to permit compliance with the Court's Order. It is not made for purposes of delay.

For these reasons, Petitioner respectfully requests that the Court extend the July 20, 2026 deadline to **August 19, 2026**. But petitioner still try to finish it as soon as possible.
