



Standardized Testing Policy

Redesigned SAT

The College Board will launch the redesigned SAT in 2016. For students graduating high school in 2016 and 2017, we will accept both the current and the redesigned version.

Test Optional Policy

- US citizens and US permanent residents: Students in this category are able to take advantage of the College's Test Optional Policy. The essay section is optional for applicants to the College who would like to submit SAT scores.
- Non-US citizens and Non-US permanent residents: Students in this category are required to submit either the SAT (including the Essay section) or ACT. This is in addition to either the TOEFL or IELTS.
- Official scores should be sent from testing agencies such as the College Board (Bryn Mawr code: 2049) or the ACT (Bryn Mawr code: 3526).
