Introduction

The data contained in this report are taken from Admissions Office Workfiles captured on the 12th Class Day of the fall semester of 2008. Numbers reported here may vary slightly from other university reports, such as the *Statistical Handbook*, issued annually by the Office of Information Management and Analysis. The *Statistical Handbook* is the University's official source of information and is posted at <http://www.utexas.edu/academic/oir/>.

This report also differs from the "Top 10% Reports" posted at <http://www.utexas.edu/student/admissions/research/>. The Top 10% Reports use a cohort of graduates of Texas high schools only. This report illustrates ALL ADMITTED FRESHMEN.

The Admitted Freshman Class of 2008 is defined as first-time admitted freshman students of the summer and fall semesters of 2008.

HB 588 "Automatic-Admits" are students automatically-admitted under the provisions of Sec. 51.803 (Texas Top 10% Law). Those students:

1. Were determined to be in the top 10% of their high school graduation class as a result of an explicit rank and class size provided by the student's high school; and
2. Graduated from a Texas high school or eligible Department of Defense school; and
3. Submitted a complete application on or before published deadlines.

"Other Admits" are students admitted under provisions outlined in Section 51.805 of the Texas Education Code.
