Optional application materials

- ▶ Students with especially strong backgrounds in music, visual art, or dance are welcome to submit supplementary materials in support of their application for admission to Smith. Materials in genres other than those referenced above will not be accepted or reviewed. Please note that all materials must be submitted electronically using [SlideRoom](#). Materials submitted by mail will not be evaluated. Smith will accept arts materials from August 1, 2015 to February 15, 2016. Materials will not be accepted for review after February 15, 2016.

Standardized Tests

- ▶ SAT I or ACT scores are optional for US Citizens and US permanent residents. Standardized tests (SAT I, ACT, TOEFL, IELTS, or PTE) are required for international citizens. The SAT I or ACT is required for students being instructed in English. The TOEFL, IELTS, or PTE is required for students being instructed in a language other than English. International students who are attending high school in the U.S. must submit SAT I or ACT scores.
- ▶ SAT II subject tests are optional for all applicants.
