We are so fortunate to have San Marcos Growers in our town. It's one of the premier Wholesale nurseries in the state!

If you don't have a wholesale license, this is a great opportunity to visit their grounds. And even if you've been there many times before as a buyer, this is a wonderful chance to have a guided personal tour with their longtime General Manager, Randy Baldwin.

Plants will not be for sale on the day of our tour. If you don't have a wholesale license, order your wish list from someone in the trade, or find the plants in your favorite nursery. Those with wholesale licenses can buy on any weekday.

In 1979 the founders of San Marcos Growers felt there was a need for a wholesale nursery with more unusual plants than were available.

Awareness of the nursery's unique product increased. They became known as a major source for plants appropriate to California's dry summer, wet winter Mediterranean climate; known for their "Plants of California" (tour if on pg. 2)
