- 1. Texas does not oppose the motions of the States or of any of them.
- 2. The claims made by the States involve questions of law and fact common to those already before the Court.
- 3. The intervention of the States will not unduly delay these proceedings or prejudice the rights of the present parties, in that fourteen of the States are represented by one counsel of record, and the other States have stated their willingness to have Texas act as lead counsel. Texas has indicated its willingness to so act as lead counsel for those States representing themselves.
