Defendant, the State of Colorado, joins the State of Wyoming in opposing the motions for leave to intervene filed by the Platte River Whooping Crane Critical Habitat Maintenance Trust and the National Audubon Society. The State of Colorado concurs in the Wyoming Memorandum in Opposition to Platte River Trust and National Audubon Society Motions for Leave to Intervene, except that the State of Colorado does not concede that allowing intervention would require the Court to consider whether Colorado has a responsibility to supply water for migratory bird habitat in eastern Nebraska from the South Platte River, or would transform this proceeding into one involving the relationship between the migratory bird habitat in eastern Nebraska and water uses in the entire North Platte, South Platte, and Platte River basins upstream in the three states.
