NOTICE OF AMENDMENT TO COMPLAINT

Pursuant to Rule 9(2) of the Rules of this Court and
Rule 15(a) of the referenced Federal Rules of Civil Proce-
dure, Plaintiffs amend their complaint herein by adding to
paragraph 4 thereof the following:

Plaintiffs further aver that the continued presence of
the said members of the Armed Forces in and near
the City of Birmingham as aforesaid for the purposes
so announced, has incited and will continue to incite
the demonstrators and rioters to continued violence for
so long as such troops remain and has obstructed and
continues to obstruct the law enforcement authorities
of the City of Birmingham, the County of Jefferson
and the State of Alabama from restoring order and
remitting the demonstrators to the lawful assertion of
their claims through the legislative and judicial agen-
cies of the government of the State of Alabama or of
the United States.
