My name is Henry Herrmann.

I am submitting this Affidavit in order to amend and supplement the one filed in support of the Motion by the Defendant Commonwealth of Massachusetts for a Preliminary Injunction on Friday, June 9, 1972.

In that Affidavit, I referred to an article appearing in the February 8th edition of the Boston Evening Globe, and stated that the Globe reporter with whom I had discussed the substance of that article had attended a Department of the Interior press conference in Washington.

The latter statement was due to a misunderstanding on my part. No one from the Boston Globe attended a press conference; rather, the substance of that February 8th article was verified two days later by Boston Globe reporter James Ayres in a telephone interview with Dr. Wayland, Chief, Conservation Division, United States Geological Survey.
