**MOTION TO DISMISS BILL
OF COMPLAINT**

*To the Honorable The Chief Justice and The Associate
Justices of the Supreme Court of the United States:*

Comes now the above named defendant, The State of Wyoming, by its Attorney General and respectfully moves the Court to make and enter an order dismissing the Bill of Complaint in Equity filed in the above entitled suit by the complainant for the following reasons, to-wit:

I.

Said Bill of Complaint shows upon its face that the State of Colorado is a necessary and indispensable party to this suit.

II.

Said Bill of Complaint shows upon its face that the Secretary of the Interior of the United States is a necessary and indispensable party to said suit.

III.

Said Bill of Complaint fails to state facts sufficient to constitute a valid cause of action in equity against this defendant and does not state any matter of equity entitling the plaintiff to the relief prayed for.

WHEREFORE, defendant prays the judgment of this Court dismissing said Bill of Complaint in Equity and dismissing said defendant with its costs.
