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By a motion for leave and proposed complaint filed herein supported by brief, the State of Illinois on behalf of its political subdivision, the Elmhurst-Villa Park-Lombard Water Commission, seeks to invoke the original jurisdiction of this honorable court in an action against the State of Minnesota and others.
