STIPULATION

STIPULATION

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the undersigned that:

- 1. The fee for the services rendered to date by the Honorable R. Ammi Cutter, Special Master herein, is set at Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000), subject to the approval of this Court;
- 2. Upon approval by this Court of the foregoing amount, and of the Consent Decree signed by the parties April 24,

- 1974, the State of Vermont agrees to pay promptly to the Special Master, Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000), and International Paper Company agrees to pay him promptly Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000);
- 3. International Paper Company will pay the disbursements of the Special Master not exceeding Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) subject to the approval of this Court, and Court costs and other disbursements (including but not limited to printing expenses) which are incidental and necessary to the entry of the Decree;
- 4. The parties hereby recommend to the Court that the Honorable R. Ammi Cutter be appointed South Lake Master, by Court order as provided in Article I of the above Consent Decree;
- 5. This stipulation shall be of no effect if the Court shall not approve the above Consent Decree and accompanying stipulation. The parties signing this stipulation severally represent that they are duly authorized to do so.
