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**Response of Moving Parties to Memorandum
of United States.**

The United States, by Memorandum dated January
1966, suggests that the Joint Motion be granted "if the
movants give assurance to the Court that (1) they will

continue, in cooperation with the Secretary of the Interior, to assemble such information as they deem necessary for presentation of their claims of present perfected rights with all reasonable expedition; and that (2) they will submit, at least to the Secretary of the Interior, partial lists of their claims of present perfected rights as soon as the necessary information is available to them.”

The moving parties have diligently endeavored to obtain information regarding claims for present perfected rights and will continue to do so. They will provide lists of claims to the Secretary of the Interior as soon as such are available, consistent with the best interests of their respective water users.
