WHETHER EMTALA PREEMPTS STATE LAWS THAT PROTECT HUMAN LIFE AND PROHIBIT ABORTIONS, LIKE IDAHO'S DEFENSE OF LIFE ACT.

ORDER OF JANUARY 5, 2024 THE APPLICATIONS FOR STAY PRESENTED TO JUSTICE KAGAN AND BY HER REFERRED TO THE COURT ARE GRANTED.
